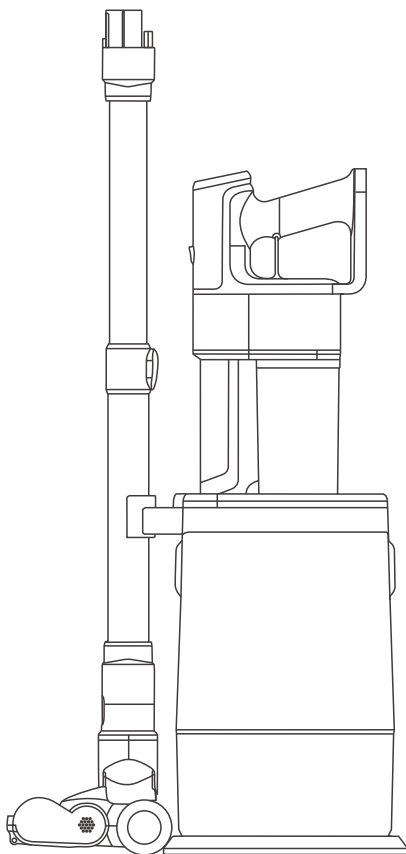

WARNINGS

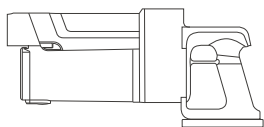
1. This vacuum cleaner is intended for household indoor use only. Do not use it for commercial or industrial purposes. 
2. Before connecting the product to a power supply, ensure that the local voltage matches the voltage specified on the station.
3. Inspect the product and the station for any damage before use.
4. Use this product strictly in accordance with the instructions in this manual. Do not attempt any maintenance or repair procedures not specified in this manual.
5. This product is not intended for use by children or persons with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning the use of the product by a person responsible for their safety.
6. Keep the product out of the reach of children. Do not allow children to use the product as a toy.
7. Keep the vacuum cleaner away from fire, heat sources, and high-temperature surfaces.
8. Do not use or store the product under extreme conditions.
9. Store the product in a cool and dry place away from direct sunlight.
10. Do not touch the plug or the product with wet hands.
11. Use only the battery originally supplied with the product. Using other batteries may result in fire, explosion, or personal injury.
12. Stop using the product immediately and contact customer service if the product malfunctions, has been dropped, damaged, or exposed to water.
13. Use only approved replacement parts and accessories.
14. Do not use the product if the plug or power cord is damaged.
15. Turn off the vacuum cleaner before cleaning, maintenance, or replacing any parts.
16. Disconnect the product from the power supply if it will not be used for an extended period of time.

17. Do not use this vacuum cleaner to pick up liquids.

25. Clean the product with a dry cloth only. Do not use gasoline, alcohol, or chemical solvents.

32. This product is equipped with a 2200 mAh rechargeable lithium battery.

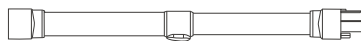
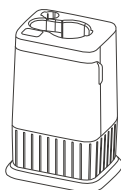

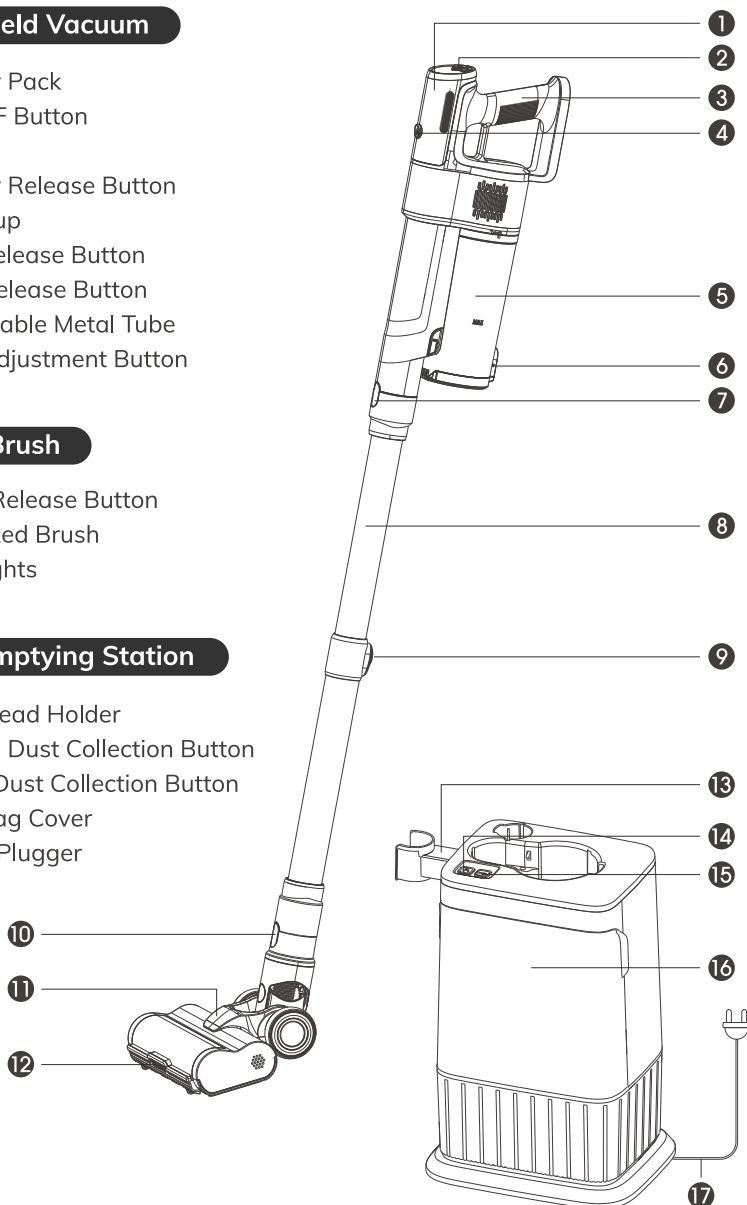

3.1 Assembly & Installation

- A click will be heard when a component has been securely connected.
- Press the component release button to detach.
- After assembly and charging, the vacuum cleaner is ready for use.

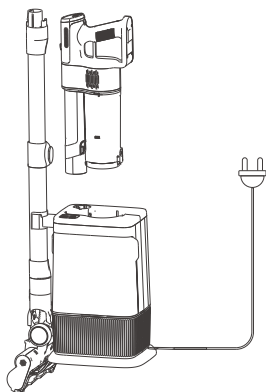


3.2 Charging

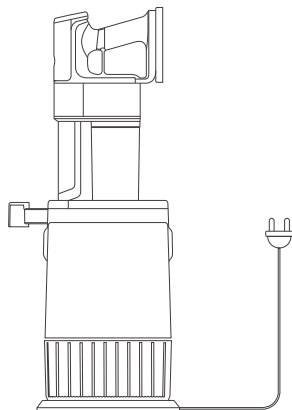
Notes:

1. The product is partially charged before delivery for safety reasons. Please charge in full before attempting to use for the first time.
2. Please note that using a charger other than the one provided together with the product may damage the battery or cause it to overheat.
3. A full charge typically takes 4–5 hours.
4. For safety reasons, the vacuum cleaner cannot be operated while charging.
5. If the product is not used for a long time, please fully charge it, remove the battery, unplug the power cord, and store it in a cool, dry place. Do not place it in direct sunlight or a humid environment. Charge the battery at least once every 3 months to avoid over-discharge.

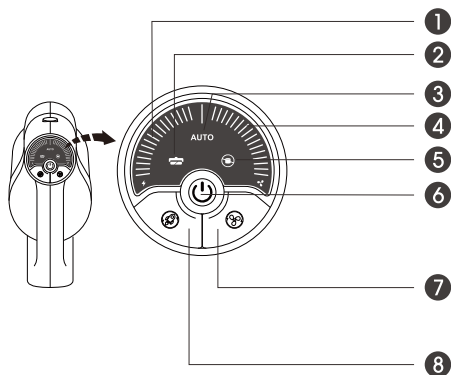

**Charging Indicator:**

- The battery indicator light flashes green during charging.
- The indicator stops flashing when it has been fully charged.

3.3 Getting Started**Control Buttons & Indicators**

- 1 Battery Indicator Light
- 2 Brush Roller Jam Indicator
- 3 AUTO Indicator Light
- 4 Speed Mode Indicator
- 5 Suction Clogging Indicator
- 6 ON/OFF Button
- 7 Speed Switch Button
- 8 One-step to Turbo Speed Mode

**Note:**

1. Speed Switch Button: Switches between Eco Mode/ Standard Mode.
2. One-step to Turbo Mode: Automatically switches back to Eco Mode after 15 seconds.

Indicator Alerts

Brush Roller Jam Indicator

- Flashes when the brush roller is blocked.
- The floor brush stops rotating and LED lights turn off.

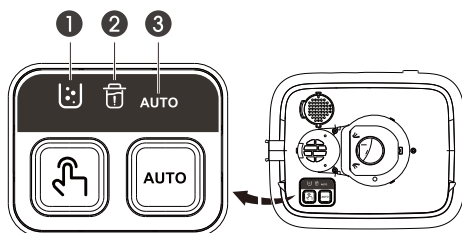
Suction Clogging Indicator

- Flashes when airflow is obstructed.
- Check the suction port, dust cup, and filters.

3.4 Using the Self-emptying Station

Indicator Lights

- 1 Manual Dust Collection Indicator
- 2 Dust Bag Full Indicator
- 3 AUTO Dust Collection Indicator



Important:

- * Install the dust bag before use. The self-emptying station will not operate without a dust bag installed.

Manual Mode

1. Insert the handheld vacuum into the self-emptying station.
2. Press the Manual Dust Collection button.
3. The self-emptying process will start and last for approximately 15–19 seconds.

Note: Use this mode for multiple-time dust collection.

AUTO Mode

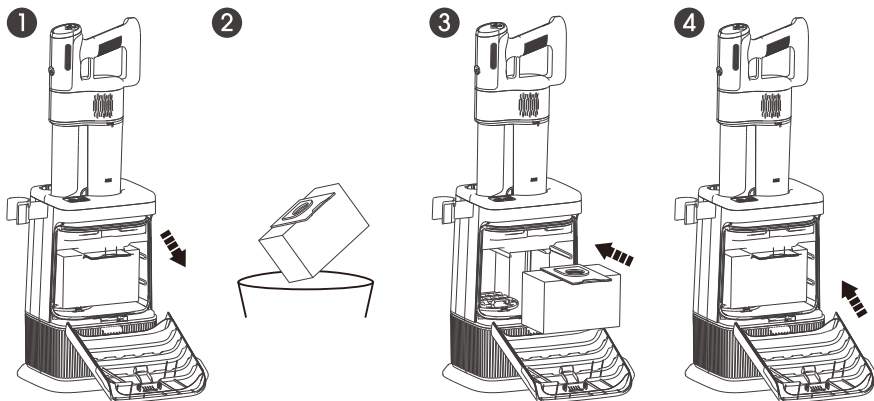
- Press the AUTO button to enable automatic dust collection.
- The self-emptying process will start and last for approximately 15–19 seconds.

Note:

Dust emptying will be triggered immediately each time the vacuum is docked.

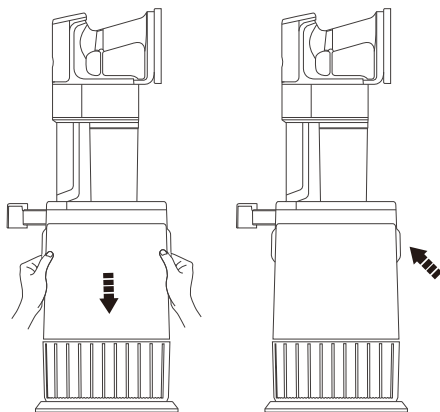
4.1 Replacing the Bag

1. Open the self-emptying station cover.
2. Remove the used dust bag.
3. Insert a new dust bag securely into the slot.
4. Close the self-emptying station cover.



Note:

1. To install the dust bag cover, press down and push into lock.
- * Do not push in without pressing down.

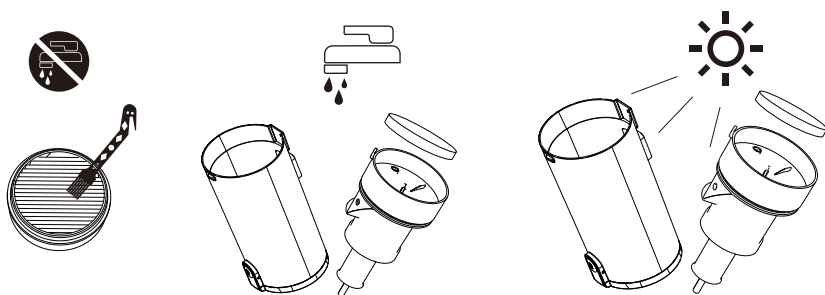
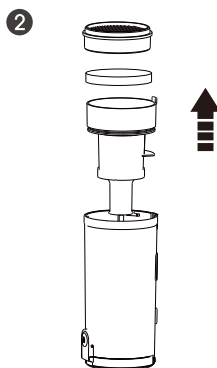
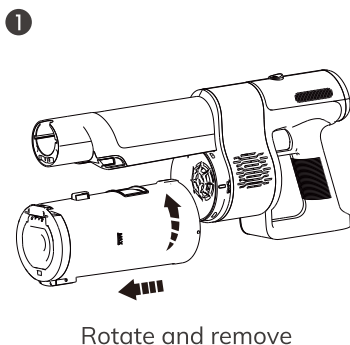


2. The vacuum bag should be replaced as soon as it has been filled up.
Remove the used dust bag and dispose of it properly in a trash bin.



4.2 Cleaning the Filter

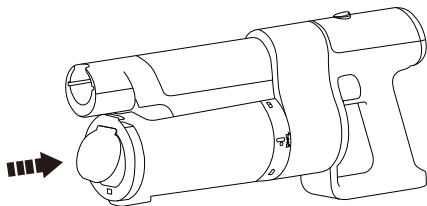
1. Hold the dust cup and rotate it to the unlock position and take it off (see Figure 1).
Lift out the filter and metal mesh assembly (see Figure 2).
2. Use a cleaning brush to remove dust from the filter.
3. Ensure that all parts are completely dry and reinstalled properly before attempting to use.



Note:

1. If you notice that suction reduces over time, try to clean the metal strainer with cold water. Do not wash the high performance filter as it may degrade after washing. Replace the filter to obtain the best performance if the suction fades.

2. If the dustbin lid becomes loose after use, inspect and clean the suction inlet with the cleaning brush. Dirt or debris around the latch may prevent the lid from locking properly. Once cleaned, press the lid firmly until it clicks securely into place.

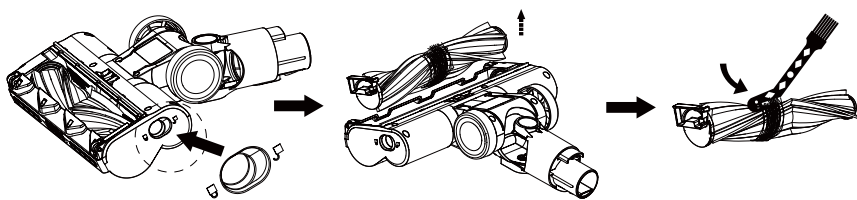


4.3 Cleaning the Motorized Brush

- The vacuum will automatically shut down if the brush roller is blocked.
- Battery indicator light will flash.

Steps:

1. Press the lock/unlock button to open the side cover.
2. Remove the roller brush.
3. Clean debris using the 2-in-1 cleaning tool.



5.1 Troubleshooting

	Dust cup full	Empty the dust cup
Weak suction	Dust cup full	Empty the dust cup
	Filter improperly installed	Reinstall the filter
	Roller tangled	Clean the roller brush
	Low battery	Fully charge the battery
	Air duct blocked	Clean air duct
	High performance filter degrades	Replace the filter
Strange sound from motor	Air duct blocked	Clean air duct
	Dust cup full	Empty the dust cup
	Filter improperly installed	Reinstall the filter
Not charging	Plug not connected properly	Reconnect the plug
	Non-original charger used	Use the original charger
